

Big White / Silver Star, Saturday March 20-27, 2010

The Erie Ski Club will be departing from Toronto Pearson Airport early Saturday morning on a direct flight to Kelowna, British Columbia. After gathering luggage, we will board a shuttle bus & make a grocery stop enroute to Big White. The group will be skiing Saturday afternoon and all day Sunday and Monday. Accommodations are at the Silver Creek studio condos, double occupancy & non-smoking. Link is www.bigwhite.com

Monday evening we will shuttle via motorcoach to Silver Star, which is about a 2-hour drive. The group will be skiing on a 3 of 4 day lift ticket and staying at the White Crystal Inn. All units have kitchenettes and are also double occupancy. Link is www.skisilverstar.com

Saturday morning we will depart via motorcoach back to the Kelowna Airport for a direct flight back to Toronto arriving Saturday night.

Some of the highlights include:

- ❖ Big White top elevation of 7606' with 2550' vertical drop, 118 marked runs, 2765 patrolled acres.
- ❖ Silver Star top elevation of 6280' with 2500' vertical drop, 115 marked runs, 3065 skiable acres.
- ❖ Both resorts are TOTALLY natural snow, no snowmaking at all.
- ❖ Extra day of skiing at Silver Star is \$40, or the potential of a day trip to Revelstoke.
- ❖ Group travel insurance is available.

Total cost of the trip is \$1250 with round trip airfare, motorcoach transfers in British Columbia, 5-day lift ticket between both resorts, complimentary guided tours and all taxes. We have only reserved 20 air seats because people from other clubs will be joining us. Airfare is first come/first served. If you are making your own air arrangements (land only) please deduct \$360.

A Friday night stop over at the Toronto Airport Hilton is available for \$40 double occupancy, with a free shuttle back & forth to the terminal. This is a great deal. Rather than paying for parking, your vehicle can be left at the hotel parking lot for the week at no additional charge.

Please remember that we are traveling to Canada and a valid passport is MANDATORY. Up North they frown upon DUI's or any other criminal record in order to be admitted to their country. The trip sign-up form is on another page of the Liftline.

We are basing this trip on 30 skiers and will be open to all members of the Cleveland Metro Ski Council and the Western Pennsylvania Ski Council after September 1st. A \$250 deposit is required to hold your spot. The balance of the payment schedule will be announced next month.
